Why is it important?

- Improved productivity and competitiveness
- Better public services

- Greater efficiency in government
- Economic reform in Europe



BRTF/Hampton proposals

- Targets to reduce administrative burdens
- Tougher scrutiny ('1 in/1 out' principle)
- Rationalisation of regulatory landscape

- Risk based approach to enforcement
- Consistency across local authorities



Government commitments

- Year on year reductions in administrative (or 'red tape') burdens on business
- Major rationalisation of regulatory landscape in private and public sectors
- Risk based approach to enforcement
- Tougher scrutiny of new measures ('1 in/1 out' principle)
- '6 Presidency' initiative in Europe

- Consultation on Better Regulation Bill

Administrative Burdens

Recommendation 1 of BRTF Report:

The Task Force recommends that...the Government should –

- Adopt the Standard Cost Model and use it to provide a systematic measurement of the administrative burden in the UK by May 2006;
- By May 2006... set a target for reducing the administrative burden; and
- By July 2005, put in place an organisational structure and necessary resources to facilitate measurement and target achievement.
